**NONPROFIT PUBLISHES CLASSIC STORIES**

*Seasons of Faith Line Features Christian Lessons, Beautiful Artwork*

Grand Rapids, Mich., June 15, 2010—In a strategic move to offer classic radio content to a new audience and in a different format, CBH Ministries came up with a plan.

“For decades, children have been sending letters telling us how their lives changed for Christ after listening to our much loved classic radio programs,” said Terre Ritchie, executive director of CBH Ministries. “We wanted to revive those great stories and draw in contemporary kids. We’ve done that with this new Seasons of Faith series.”

Each book encourages children to learn about their faith in God. “If a child is having difficulty witnessing, we have a book that shows how to share their faith without fear,” said Mrs. Ritchie. “If a child is hurting, we have another book to show them how to rely on Christ. Our two new books deal with salvation and the importance of living like a true child of the King of kings.”

The Seasons of Faith line is also unique because of its link to a time when radio was the evening’s primary entertainment. “Families used to listen to these radio programs every night before bed,” Mrs. Ritchie said. “Now they can read the books and, like the good ol’ days, listen to the story read by Uncle Charlie. Reading these books is one way for parents and grandparents to pass on their legacy of faith to their precious little ones.”

The two new books in the Seasons of Faith series are *The King’s Daughter* and *The Red Boat*. Additional books in the line are *Race with Midnight*, *You Can’t Come In*, *Seventy Times Seven* and *Braving the Storm* and are available now; each copy includes a CD of long-time radio personality Uncle Charlie narrating the story.
